

INFORMATION ON PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING CA' SELECT ARTE CALL

1. Introduction

This information on the processing of personal data is provided by **Montenegro S.r.l.** (hereafter also referred to as '**Montenegro**', and/or the '**Company**', and/or the '**Data Controller**'), located at Via Enrico Fermi 4, Zola Predosa. As data controller, Montenegro hereby informs you that the personal data of users (hereafter '**Users**' or '**Subjects**') participating in the Ca' Select Arte Call (hereafter the '**Call**') organized by the Company, will be processed using the methods indicated below and nevertheless in compliance with applicable regulations on the processing of personal data, particularly Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (hereafter the '**Privacy Regulation**') and Legislative Decree 196/2003, as last modified and/or integrated by Legislative Decree 2018/101 (hereafter the '**Privacy Code**').

2. Who is the Data Controller?

Montenegro, which may be contacted via email at privacy.montenegrocorporate@montenegro.it, is the Data Controller of the Subjects' personal data, which will be processed using the means and for the purposes described in this information on personal data processing (hereafter the '**Privacy Information**').

3. What type of Personal Data is processed by the Company?

The company collects and processes the following personal data for subsequent registration and participation in the Call, or for placement on the associated waiting list, in particular:

- a) identifiers such as first name and surname, date of birth, and nationality;
- b) contact information, including address, phone number, and email address;

(hereafter collectively called '**Personal Data**').

Nevertheless, the Company will not collect and/or process particular categories of personal information in compliance with Article 9 of the Privacy Regulation.

4. For what purposes is my Personal Data processed?

The Company will process your Personal Data using both manual and electronic tools:

- a) to allow for registration and participation in the Call;

(hereafter collectively called '**Contractual Purposes**');

- b) to comply with possible legal and regulatory obligations ('**Legal Purposes**'); and
- c) to carry out activities related to the transfer of the company and company branches, acquisitions, mergers, demergers, or other transformations, and to carry out these operations, as well as to exercise and defend, even in court, the Company's rights regarding Subjects and/or third parties ('**Purposes of Legitimate Business Interests**').

5. What is the legal basis for the processing?

Your Personal Data must be processed for the Contractual and Legal Purposes listed in Section 4, letters a) and b), that is, for your registration and participation in the Call and to fulfil possible legal or regulatory obligations. If you do not want your Personal Data to be processed for these purposes, it will not be possible for you to register or participate in the Call organized by the Company.

Your Personal Data is processed for the Purposes of Legitimate Business Interests as per Section 4, letter c), according to Article 6, letter f) of the Privacy Regulation, to pursue the Company's legitimate interests, which are balanced with the Subject's legitimate interests, since the processing of Personal Data is limited to what is strictly necessary to perform the operations described above. Processing for the Purposes of Legitimate Interests is not required and you may object to such processing by contacting the Data Controller via the means listed in Section 9 below. If you object to this processing, your Personal Data may not be used for the Purposes of Legitimate Business Interests, unless the Company illustrates the presence of compelling overriding legitimate reasons or to exercise or defend a right pursuant to Article 21 of the Privacy Regulation.

6. Who has access to my Personal Data?

For Contractual or Legal Purposes and Legitimate Business Interests, your Personal Data may be disclosed to the following third parties located within the European Union: (a) employees, consultants, and/or processors appointed by the Company; (b) third-party providers of assistance and consultation, even through call centres, with reference but not limited to activities in the technological, accounting, administrative, legal, and insurance sectors; (c) other companies in the group the Company belongs to; and (d) the competent authorities.

For the Purposes of Marketing and Legitimate Marketing Interests, your Personal Data may be transferred to the following categories of recipients located within the European Union: (a) employees, consultants, and/or processors appointed by the Company; (b) marketing companies organizing events; (c) third-party providers of assistance and consultation, even through call centres, with regard to sending marketing communications and conducting preference analysis; and (d) other companies in the group to which the Company belongs.

Depending on the situation, these recipients will process your Personal Data as controllers responsible or appointed for its processing. The complete, updated list of subjects that may process your Personal Data as Data Processors is available from the Data Controller by request using the means of contact indicated in Section 9 of this Privacy Information.

7. Will my Personal Data be transferred out of the country?

Your Personal Data will not be transferred to countries outside the European Economic Area.

8. What are my rights with respect to my Personal Data?

Without prejudice to the possibility for Subjects to withhold Personal Data or to the effects of Section 4 above, you may exercise the following rights at any time and at no charge by contacting the Data Controller in accordance with the procedures set out in Section 9 below. You may (i) obtain confirmation of the existence or not of your Personal Data; (ii) know the origin of your Personal Data, the purposes of processing and the methods used, as well as the logic applied to processing using electronic tools; (iii) request that your Personal Data be updated, rectified, or — if you have an interest in doing so — integrated; (iv) cancel, anonymize, or block any Personal Data processed in violation of the law, as well as oppose processing for legitimate reasons; (v) request that the Company limit processing of your Personal Data in the event that (1) you, as Subject, contest the accuracy

of your Personal Data, for the time necessary for the Company to verify the accuracy of said Personal Data; (2) the processing is unlawful and you object to the erasure of your Personal Data, instead requesting that its use be limited; (3) the Personal Data are necessary for you to establish, exercise, or defend a right in court, even though the Company no longer needs your Personal Data for processing purposes; or (4) you have objected to the processing pursuant to Article 21, Section 1 of the Privacy Regulation pending verification of whether the Data Controller's legitimate reasons prevail over yours; (vi) object at any time to the processing of your Personal Data for the purposes of legitimate interests, except where the Company has overriding legitimate reasons or needs to assert or defend a right in any legal proceedings; (vii) request the deletion of your Personal Data without undue delay; (viii) obtain your Personal Data for portability; or (ix) submit a complaint to the Information Commissioner where applicable.

In the event of the Subject's death, the above-mentioned rights referring to his/her Personal Data may be exercised by those with an interest in or acting on behalf of the Subject as his/her agent, or for valid family reasons related to protection. Subjects may expressly prohibit their successors from exercising any of the above-listed rights by sending a written declaration to the Company at the email address listed below; said declaration may later be revoked or modified via the same means.

9. How can I contact the Data Controller?

10. For how long will my Personal Data be stored?

The company will process your Personal Data for the period strictly necessary for the purposes listed in Section 4 above, and nevertheless:

- for the period of the Call and the following 10 years for the Contractual Purposes and Legitimate Business Interests listed in Section 4, letters a) and c); and
- for the period defined by law for each type of data for the Legal Purposes listed in Section 4, letter b).

11. Modifications and Updates

The present information is valid from the effective date indicated below. Nevertheless, the company may, with prior notice, modify and/or integrate this Privacy Information, even due to possible later regulatory modifications and/or integrations.
